

USA's EMPLOYEE COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

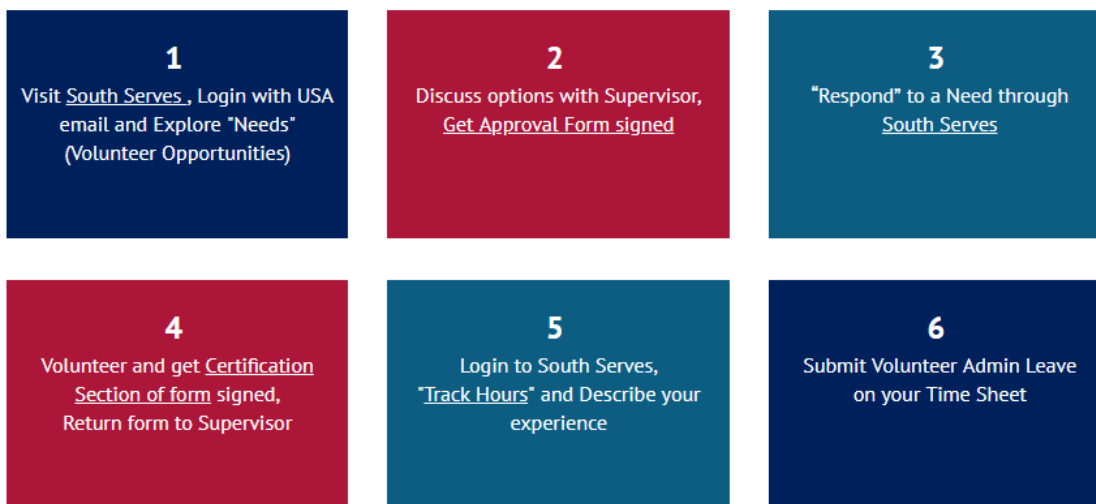
The USA Employee Community Volunteer Program is an initiative of President Tony Waldrop that is administered by the USA Office of Community Engagement. In recognition of the enormously generous spirit of the employees of USA, this program provides **8 hours of paid administrative leave annually** to support employee volunteer efforts. Participation in the program is available to *all full-time employees in good standing who have been employed at USA for at least one year.*

To find and follow these required 6 steps:



Please note:

- ✓ Supervisors **must** approve the Volunteer Leave **BEFORE** an employee volunteers.
- ✓ Employees must submit their time in SOUTH SERVES, the USA volunteer management system found on the Office of Community Engagement website.
- ✓ USA Employees **who do not follow the 6 steps** will have their Volunteer Leave converted to PTO, vacation or unpaid leave (whichever is appropriate for their personal situation).
- ✓ Volunteers are encouraged to use SOUTH SERVES to report their service, even when it is not a part of the Employee Volunteer Program (we want to celebrate and notice individuals and departments for all they do).
